Benson, Jehoshaphat and the team at Kagando wanted us to send on their Easter greetings to all the 'Friends of Kagando'. Their message was – 'Because He lives, we can face tomorrow' What courage and faith they have to serve the Lord in that place and to trust the risen Jesus with their 'tomorrows'.

Two doctors and their wives (Ralph and Ceri Settatree and Richard and Jane Gill) have recently been to visit Kagando to do medical work, and came back with news on different aspects of the project. Maureen Moore who was matron at Kagando for many years has also visited and had contact with old friends and colleagues.

The hospital is very busy, particularly the paediatric ward where there are at least 2 children to every bed.

Fistula operations continue regularly and they did twelve during their 2 week visit.

The building for the xray is making good progress now that money has come in to finance that, and they hope to be operational by the end of May.

The Mothers care home – where expectant mothers, from outlying rural areas, come to wait for the birth of their baby – now has 11 twin bedded rooms completed.

Many churches and individuals have given sacrificially in recent months for the work at Kagando which has been much appreciated. One of the great benefits of the increased giving is that the staff are now mostly able to receive their salaries at the end of each month.

Two containers have now been sent to Kagando and their sister hospital, Kisiizi, in the last six months and all the contents arrived intact.
